Dear Parents

Whole school trip to Fort Victoria

We have planned a whole school trip to Fort Victoria on Friday 9th July, to celebrate our year and explore our natural environment. The children will be engaged in Ranger tours and talks, visits to the Aquarium for Rainbow, Sunshine and Sky class and visits to the Shipwreck museum for Cirrus and Zephyr class as well as having time for fun and games

The PTFA have **very kindly** funded a large proportion of the day, however I am asking for a voluntary contribution of £1.50 to meet the full cost of the day.

We are requesting that parents / carers drop off and pick up from Fort Victoria as the trip will cost considerably more if we use coach services. Transport will be provided for those children who regularly attend breakfast and after school club.

We ask that children are dropped off between 9.00 and 9.15 when the registers will be called. Collection will begin at 2.30 until 2.45 enabling a staggered pick up [as at the end of the day]. We would welcome parents joining us for all or part of the day enabling us to have a school community day. The PTFA would also welcome support in erecting Gazebos from 8.45 allowing shade if the weather is warm. [In the event of very poor weather the event may be cancelled]

Children will need a packed lunch, suitable trousers/ shorts and shoes [school tee shirts/jumpers should be worn] as well as a rain mack if the weather is changeable. They will also need a water bottle [separate from lunchtime drink] and have sun screen applied prior to the visit, some to "top up" at lunchtime and a hat. £1.00, in a named sealed envelop, for an ice lolly can also be given to staff on the day
