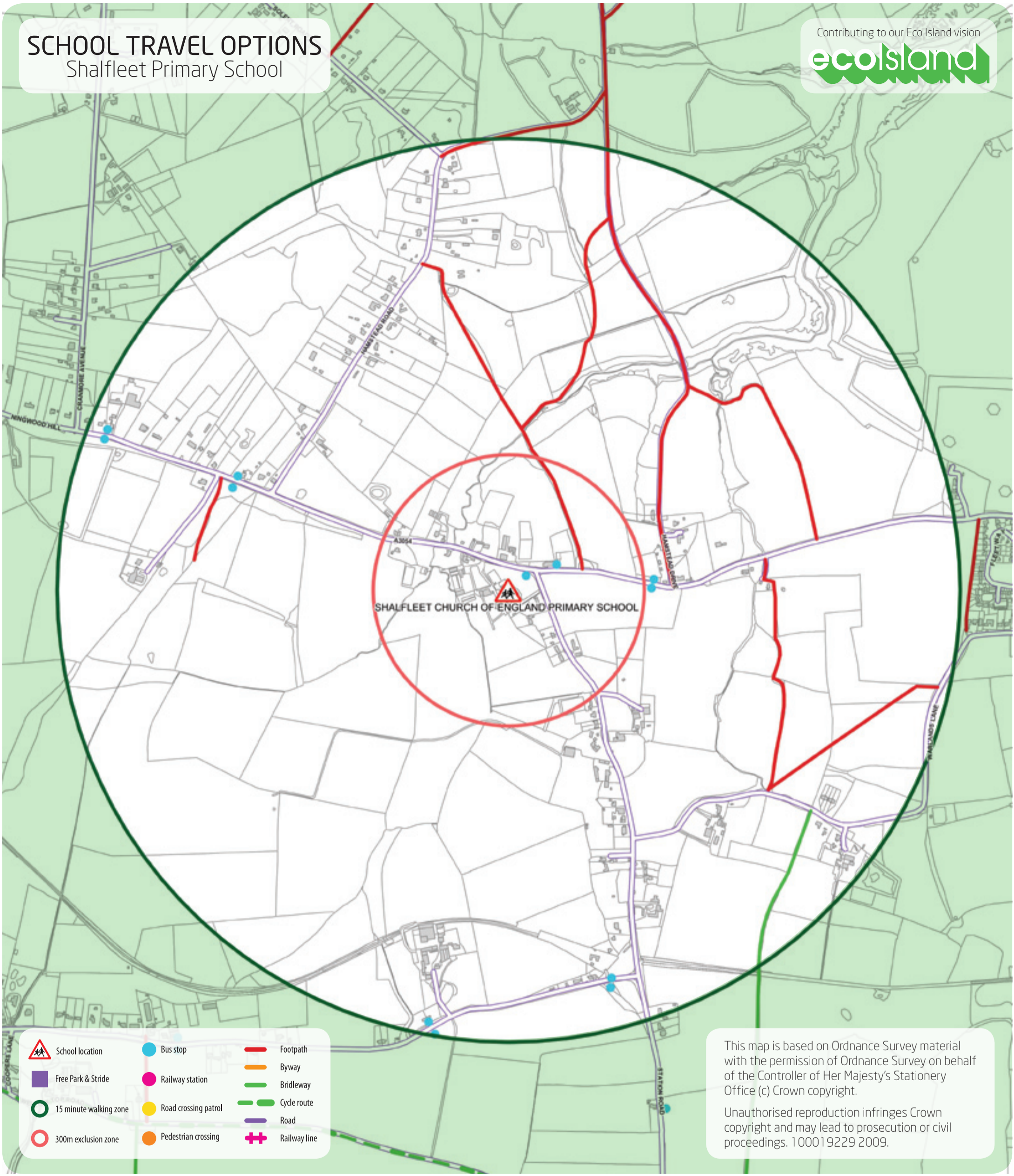


SCHOOL TRAVEL OPTIONS

Shalfleet Primary School

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Walking

It takes around fifteen minutes to walk from any point in the green circle on the map to Shalfleet Primary School. The footpaths, shown in red, can offer quick short cuts, but they are not often lit and may not be suitable for winter use. Pedestrians can use byways and off-road cycle routes too.

Pedestrian zebra and pelican crossings, if available, are shown as an orange dot on the map. If there is a road crossing patrol, shown as a yellow dot, this is where a 'lollipop person' is available during term time. Please support your child to use these crossings safely. Please be aware that there may be times that the road crossing patrol may not be there.

Public transport

The nearest bus stops to the school, shown as blue dots on the map, are on Main Road.

Car

Parking at the school is strictly controlled for safety reasons - please contact the school regarding the Drop Off and Carshare Schemes. Please try to park outside the voluntary exclusion zone to keep the area safe and clear for pedestrians and cyclists. Zigzags and double yellow lines outside schools are there to keep your child safe - please **do not** park on them at any time.

Cycling and scooters

Contact the school for details of where to leave bikes, helmets and gear. Check out designated cycle routes and bridleways, which bikes can use, shown in green on the map.

Bikes can use bridleways and cycle routes but cycling is not allowed on footpaths. Please use these areas considerably, and that way they are suitable for pedestrians, cyclists, disabled users, horse-riders and dog-walkers alike.
